

One-Page Mode

1. The plan for this chapter will be to learn about the features and navigation of the One-Page Mode
2. Let's get started! Clicking on the **page** icon, a student can choose to work in One-Page Mode. This is what the students sees when she goes to One-Page Mode. As we mentioned earlier in the tutorial, in Level 3 when a student starts a work she is brought directly to the One-Page Mode.
3. Since this page is long you can work with your class in steps. A student can always go to the Multiple-Page Mode by clicking on this icon and work in steps if she prefers.
4. A student can also work in steps by choosing one section on this list: **Goals**, **Content** and **Reflections**. The student then clicks on **Goals** to work on this section. After she is done this section, she can click on the **top button** to go back to the top of her artifact.
5. Then, the student clicks on **Content** and works on this section. After she is done with this section, she can click on the **top button** to go back to the top of his artifact.
6. Then, the student clicks on **Reflections** and works on this section. After she is done this section, she can click on the **top button** to go back to the top of her artifact. There is no prescribed order in which students are required to navigate through ePEARL. For instance, a teacher may encourage a student to pause and reflect part way through an assignment.
7. Reflecting: In what ways might the one page mode be easier for student to use? Which sections are you ready to start working on with your class?
TIP: You can go **step-by-step**: implement some sections of this One-Page Mode and keep adding as the student progresses in her self-regulated process of learning.
