

### Doing in the One-Page Mode

1. The plan for this chapter will be to learn about:
  - How to add content to a new artifact using the One-Page Mode
  - The technological features that ePEARL offers to the student: to write the work typing in the text editor, to record herself and to attach files.
2. Let's get started! Now that Megan has finished planning, she is ready to add content to her portfolio. In this section a student will be able to: Record, Write work using the text editor; Add links related to work, Attach files that relate to an artifact and describe which applications were used to complete the work. These powerful resources stimulate the student's creativity, ICT as well as oral and written skills.
